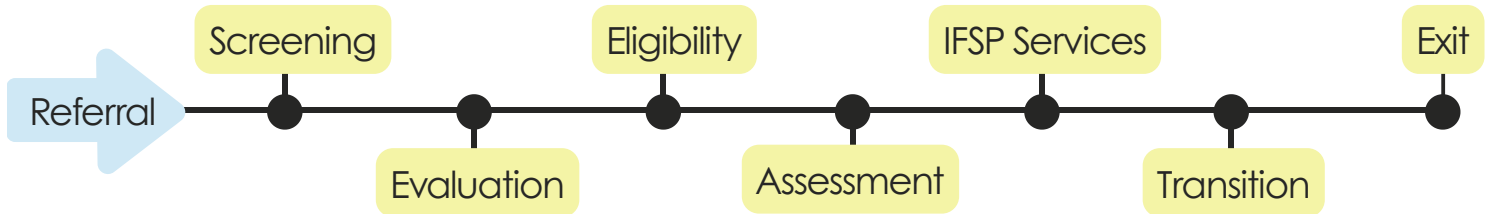


Prior Written Notice (PWN): Quick Guide

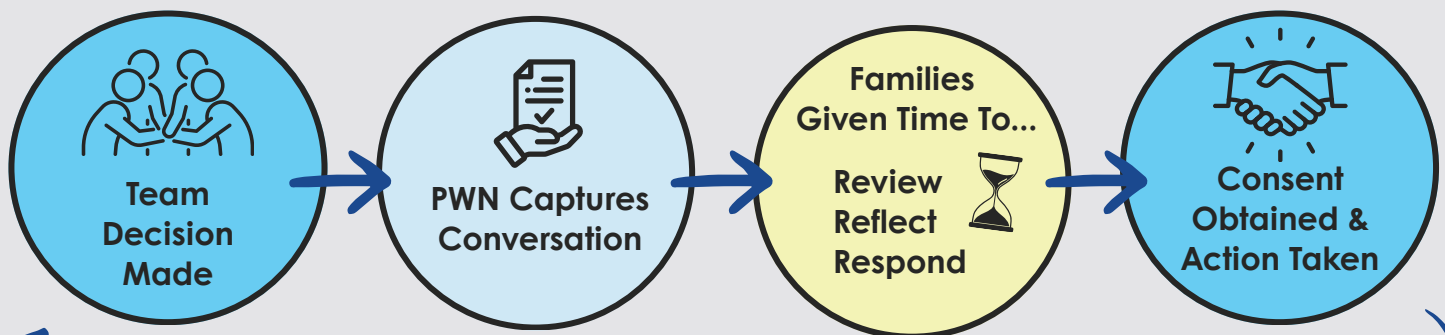
PWN is written notice to families before an Early Intervention action is taken. It explains what the program proposed or refused, why, what information was used, other options considered, and the family's rights.

Throughout the Birth to 3 Program Journey

PWN is needed across the entire Birth to 3 Program process - from screening through exit - whenever specific actions are proposed or refused.
